DeKalb Workforce Development (DWD) is requesting an electronic vote to approve the below agenda items. Payment of Final Invoice from MYP

MYP was one of the 2009 Youth Summer Employment contractors. The contract expired September 30, 2009, with the last day to submit invoices for reimbursement December 15, 2009. However, on June 17, 2010, MYP presented a final invoice in the amount of \$10,007.50 for program close-out work. Payment of the final invoice will not exceed the contract amount of \$300,000. In that the contract has expired and on recommendation from DeKalb County Purchasing and Contracting Department, DWD is requesting approval and recommendation from the Youth Council to pay the final invoice.

Acceptance of WIA Formula Funds

DeKalb Workforce Development received the youth grant award \$1,969,140 from Georgia Department of Labor. The purpose of the funds is to help low income youth, between the ages of 14 and 21, acquire the educational and occupational skills, work-readiness training, and support needed to achieve academic and employment success. We are requesting acceptance of these funds by the Youth Council.

Revision of Youth Eligibility

In order to align DeKalb Workforce Development’s policy for eligibility with federal standards, we are requesting to revise youth eligibility of income plus two barriers to income plus one barrier. Barriers are *deficient in basic literacy skills, school dropout, homeless or runaway, foster child, pregnant or parenting, and offender*. DeKalb Workforce Development will continue to assess income as the initial basis of eligibility.



Purchase of Gift Cards for Summer Program Participants

DeKalb Workforce Development would like to purchase school and work supplies in the form of gift cards (value not to exceed \$200) for both summer programs, GDOL/DHS and WIA Summer Employment. Participants will receive two incentive awards of \$100 each at midpoint and at completion of the program, for a total of \$200 per eligible youth. Gift cards will be awarded to participants that successfully complete their summer employment work experience.
